The **Willa A. Washington/Hazelwood Community Association Community Justice Scholarship** will be available to all UC Blue Ash students, starting with the 2016-17 academic year. It will award two scholarships worth \$500 each to deserving students every year.

Requirements for consideration:

- Student must maintain a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 and must submit an essay about their definition of community justice.
- Preference is given to students from the Hazelwood community in Blue Ash, but applicants from other communities will also be considered.
