The HRC works to promote and ensure a culture of fair treatment and equal access to opportunities for all who live, work, play, and gather in the City of Dayton. The Council investigates and adjudicates discrimination complaints, implements procurement programs that provide opportunities to minority, female, and small disadvantaged business enterprises and provides business technical assistance to support capacity building. In addition, the Council administers community relations

programs focused on immigrant integration, improving community police relations, reducing gun violence and other activities that support the mission of the organization.

Katy serves on several nonprofit Boards including the National Community Reinvestment Coalition, Dayton Dialogue on Race Relations, and Wright State University's Foundation Board of Trustees.
