Obviously there could be issues by allowing the defendant access back into the residence, but Officer [REDACTED] would have encountered those issues by pursuing him into the residence like he did. I would like to ensure that Officer [REDACTED] was thinking about other alternatives at the time other than just simply running after the defendant.
